Danic Technology, Inc. announced today that the Company has released the Developer Edition of Danic Tools. The feature-rich Developer Edition is specifically designed for those agencies with IT staff interested in building their own customized systems. The developer edition is a big step-up from the commonly used Access and File-maker Pro solutions. In-house staff can build custom client / server and web-enabled systems in a fraction of the time otherwise required--systems truly integrated and feature rich (scheduling, billing, triggers). As important, Danic is there to provide the back-up needed. The agency doesn't find itself dependent solely on its in-house IT staff or consultants for the continued operation of the system.

The hallmark of Danic Tools has long been the ease with which it can be configured and reconfigured to fit the particular and changing needs of virtually any agency. It has been implemented in organizations providing services in the areas of developmental disabilities, mental health, child and family services, juvenile justice, employee assistance programs (EAP), and more. It is most commonly used for client management purposes, but is increasingly being used for human resources, fund raising and other agency purposes. Thanks to Danic's elegant meta-model, database and interface configurations can be modified without changing the source code; agencies are thus able to reconfigure the system themselves without vendor help.
